

Every pupil has their own LRC card and can borrow up to three items and these are on loan for three weeks. If you are unable to finish something within the three weeks please come to LRC to have it renewed. It is best to bring your item to have the new return date stamped on it. If you forget and need to renew it you will be given a date slip with the new return date on it.



You are responsible for anything borrowed on your card, please do not borrow items for anyone else. Anything lost or damaged must be replaced.

Books can be borrowed over the holidays so make sure they are renewed before the end of term.

The LRC is available for study after school every night. Books, PC's and CDRoms are always available. There are 12 PC's available in the LRC and these can be booked for interval and lunchtimes.

The Careers Library is based in the LRC. An advisor from Skills Development Scotland is available every Tuesday and appointments to see the advisor can be made in the LRC at any time.

The LRC has a very relaxed atmosphere and you are welcome to come in at any time, but there are a few important guidelines you must follow to ensure the LRC runs effectively.

- Do not borrow items for anyone else. You are responsible for anything borrowed on your card.
- When you return items make sure you give them to a member of staff or LRC Helper. NEVER leave returned items on the desk or put them back on the shelf without having them taken off your card.
- No food, drink or mobile phones are allowed in the LRC.
