The LRC has a very relaxed atmosphere and you are welcome to come in at any time, but there are a few important guidelines you must follow to ensure the LRC runs effectively.

- Do not borrow items for anyone else. You are responsible for anything borrowed on your card.
- When you return items make sure you give them to a member of staff. NEVER leave returned items on the desk or put them back on the shelf without having them taken off your card.
- No food is allowed in the LRC. Bottled water is allowed in the classroom area. Mobile phones can be used but taking photographs is prohibited in the LRC.
- Bags and jackets must be stored in the boxes provided. Make sure the fire door is kept clear.
- Make sure shelves are tidy when you leave the LRC.
